In our endeavor to align Mobilus content more closely with terminology commonly used across the industry, SAE International has reorganized its content according to the definitions below.

Books

Text-based content about the process, progress, or results of technical or scientific research that follows a specific format, is submitted for peer review, and is often presented at a conference

Handbook

A nonfiction book that contains advice or instructions about how to do something or that highlights the most important information about a subject

Narrative

A book that is intended for consecutive reading

Picture Book

A book intended for children with illustrations on most pages

Reference

A nonfiction book typically intended for consultation not consecutive reading

Textbook

A book intended for use in educational courses

Courses

Instructor Led Educational courses overseen by a teacher

eLearning

Educational courses that are solely online and often self-guided

Standards

Characteristic

Standards that define the form, fit, function, and interfaces of avionics, cabin systems, and aircraft networks

Information Report

A standard detailing consensus-based definitions and guidance for the parameters used to create other standards

Material Specification

A standard detailing consensus-based, ballot-approved requirements for creation and construction of materials

Recommended Practice

A standard detailing consensus-based, ballot-approved industry ideal for procedures or configurations

Specification

Standards that define the physical packaging or mounting of avionics and cabin equipment, communication, networking and data security standards, or a high-level computer language

Supplement

Content that provides additional information for standards but are not standards themselves

Technical Standard

A standard detailing consensus-based, ballot-approved industry norms that does not fall under other standards categories

EDGE Research Report

Text-based content that presents the findings of a research project and is not peer reviewed

Journal

A scholarly serial publication, typically divided into volumes and issues, containing several articles about the same niche topic

Journal Article

Scholarly short-form, text-based content published alongside similar content in a serial publication intended for subject experts

Magazine

A popular or trade serial publication, typically divided into volumes and issues, containing several articles about the same broad topic

Magazine Issue

A single publication containing several magazine articles released at the same time

Magazine Article

Short-form content consisting of both text and images published alongside similar content in a serial publication intended for a general or trade audience

Technical Paper

Text-based content about the process, progress, or results of technical or scientific research that follows a

specific format, is submitted for peer review, and is often presented at a conference

Other content filters

Best Practice

A consensus-based report about industry norms that does not go through a ballot and approval process

Podcast

Serial audio content released digitally

Proceedings

A serial publication containing selected and converted technical papers from previous conferences and events

Software

Programs to do a specific task on the computer

Video

A recording of moving images, often accompanied by audio

White Paper

Text-based content that gives a concise overview of a specific topic
